From the Desk of Secretary

Ghosh, Dr Rajesh Kumar, Dr Dilip Kumar Barui, Dr Abdullah Sohail, Dr Chhanda Ray Mondal, Dr Supti Bala belongs to our alumni family.

During the first wave of the pandemic we have lost Dr Sisir Kumar Mondal, Dr Shuvendu Bhandari, Dr Bikash Bose, Dr Kanchan Dey, Dr Amal Manna, Dr Kishore Nandi, Dr Sujan Kumar Mitra, Dr Rajendra Golcha, Dr Sudip Kumar Mukherjee, Dr Hasi Dasgupta, Dr Biswajit Bandopadhyay, Dr Arjun Das, Dr Subhra Paul, Dr Debdas Saha, Dr Arabindo Ghosh. May their departed soul rest in peace. Our prayer lies with their bereaved family members. My sincere thanks to Dr Somanth Sorcar, Organising Secretary of 68th Reunion and his Team for transferring their surplus fund to Alumni Association.

Due to Covid-19 pandemic 70th Reunion could not be organised in the month of February 2021. On 6th February 2021, prior to 10th EC meeting flag hoisting ceremony was organised at college campus in presence of Principal CNMC Prof Ajay Kumar Ray and the members. This was followed by garlanding of Martyr's Memorial and statues of Deshbandhu Chittaranjan Das, Dr Kumud Sankar Ray, Dr M N Sarkar and Dr Sundari Mohan Das. With much discussion an idea of organising reunion in new normal situation was conceived. New Normal Reunion 2021 was organised on 3rd and 4th April 2021 in dual platforms (both physical and virtual) which was appreciated by all A sketch of New Normal Reunion 2021 has been outlined in the "Reminiscences of New Normal Reunion 2021" heading.

Immediately after the reunion, a health camp was organised on 12th April 2021 in "Astarag", an old age home run by CPT Officer's Wives' Association. About 44 elderly residents and 14 caregivers of the old age home were examined. Facilities like eye check up including refraction, general health check up, ECG, CBG measurement and neuropathy studies were set up. Executive committee members of the old age home (Astarag), expressed their thanks and gratitude after the camp was over and requested for a follow up health camp after a certain interval. Supercyclone Yaash has caused massive devastation in Sagar Islands including Ghoramara island. Members of executive committee have expressed deep concern and forwarded their views to stand by the side of Yaash victims. Accordingly a team comprising President, Vice-president, Secretary and EC members visited Sagar Island on 19th June 2021 and handed over Rs 80,000/- to Ramakrishna Mission, Manasadwip, Sagar Island. In addition EC members have also donated individually. With these financial support essential commodities (utensils and garments) were distributed amongst 100 homeless families. Besides, santizers, cloth masks, soaps were distributed to the residents of the Ashram.

On 1st July 2021 Doctor's Day was observed in Eastern Lecture Theatre. After the inaugural song one minute silence was observed for the Covid Martyrs. This year Doctor's Day was observed as Covid Martyr's Day. We have lost 748 of our colleagues during the last 9 months (first wave) and 776 colleagues during last 9 weeks (2nd wave). President welcomed the distinguished guests and the members present in the morning. Prof (Dr) Debasis Bhattacharyya, Director of Medical Education in his speech highlighted the extraordinary clinical acumen of Dr Bidhan Chandra Roy and he wanted to impress the new generation of doctors on sympathy towards our patients. Principal Prof (Dr) Ajay Kumar Ray and MSVP Prof (Dr) Shyamapada Pati have also graced the occasion. In a discussion a proposal was raised regarding placement of bust of Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay, an ex-student of our institution for his pioneer work in the field of reproductive medicine which lead to the first test tube baby in India. A written proposal was forwarded to the Principal Calcutta National Medical College on this including renaming of Gynae block of Calcutta National Medical College and Hospital as Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay Block. As a Secretary I appeal to all the students, interns, housestaffs and natmeds to come forward during this tough time with all possible way of participation thereby enriching our Alumni Association.
