Principal Dr Harendra Nath Ghosh – whom I have seen



In July 1978, when I was transferred as Resident Physician to Calcutta National Medical College & Hospital, I met Prof. H N Ghosh working as Principal CNMC and Superintendent of Calcutta Medical College & Chittaranjan Hospital. He advised me to work sincerely for patients, specially poor patients.

I remember his activities as he loved his students and for them he opened a hostel in Linton Street. He also loved his housestaffs and for them he tried to engage them even after their term was over. It was Dr H N Ghosh who first encouraged to start pacemaker implantation in patients in Cardiology department of Calcutta National Medical College & Hospital in the



year 1985. He used to share his tiffin with those who came to meet him in Principal's Chamber including myself. He used to work till 1 pm in the hospital and used to visit Medical and Surgical department and also other departments of the hospital. After 1 pm he used to come to Principal's Room in the college campus. He was also the head of the department of Physiology and author of a well known Physiology book for the medicos. I pray to the almighty that his departed soul finds eternal peace in heaven.



Unveiling of bust of Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay

The bust of Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay was unveiled on 15th April 2022, ১লা বৈশাখ ১৪২৯ সন, on the first day of 70th Reunion by Prof. (Dr.) Debasish Bhattacharya, Director of Medical Education, Government of West Bengal in presence of Prof. (Dr.) Ajay Kumar Ray, Principal CNMC, Dr Argha Moitra, MSVP CNMC, Office bearers and members of Alumni Association.

Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay-a bright son of Calcutta National Medical College (16th January 1931-19th June 1981)

Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay was born on 16th January 1931 in Hazaribag, Bihar, India (now in Jharkhand). He studied B Sc (Hons. in Physiology) from Calcutta University. He joined MBBS in 1949 in Calcutta National Medical College (2nd batch). He stood first in Gynaecology and obtained Hemangini Scholarship. In 1958 Dr Subhas Mukhopadhyay received PhD degree in Physiology under the stewardship of Prof. Sachidananda Banerjee from Calcutta University. He also obtained PhD from Edinburg University in Reproductive Endocrinology and found out a new method for assay of LH for which no reliable method was available at that time. The technique depends on ovarian cholesterol depletion of intact immature rats pretreated with PMSG and HCG. He also worked at the Royal Infirmary London.

Prof. Subhas Mukhopadhyay is considered to be the pioneer of In Vitro Fertilization (IVF) in India which lead to the birth of "Durga" (Kanupriya Agarwal) on 3rd October 1978. Only 67 days earlier, "Loise Browne", the world's first IVF baby (test tube baby popularly known as) was born in England due to the pioneering work of Prof. Robert G. Edwards, Physiologist and Dr Patrick Steptoe, Gynecologist. Dr Mukhopadhyay's method was different from that followed by Steptoe and Edwards and it was the world's first test tube baby from frozen and thawed embryo. He published his papers in Indian Journal of Cryogenics and presented his findings in the Indian Science Congress, in January 1979. He discussed his experiments in the "Fifth International Congress on Hormonal Steroids 1978" held at New Delhi in November-December 1978. He also discussed the matter with Professor John Biggers of the Laboratory of Human Reproduction, Harvard Medical School, USA and Professor B B Saxena, Prof. of Biochemistry and Endocrinology of Cornell University Medical School in USA and Professor Kenneth Ryan, Prof of Gynaecology of Harvard.

Prof. Rober G. Edwards was conferred the Nobel Prize in 2010, while Dr Mukhopadhyay received non recognition and humiliation from different corners. Dejected he committed suicide on 19th June 1981, at the age of fifty.

The works of Prof. Subhas Mukhopadhyay would not have seen light of the day if DrTC Anand, former Director, ICMR-NIRRH acclaimed and endorsed his work and presented to the national and international medical fraternity. DrTC Anand was credited with the birth of first scientifically documented IVF baby in India.

Prof. Sunit Mukherjee, a food technologist and an associate in the works of Prof. Mukhopadhyay, has been greatly instrumental in preserving and propagating the works of Prof. Mukhopadhyay. Prof Mukhopadhyay's method of IVF is the most accepted procedure in the present day practice across the world.

Prof Mukhopadhyay was the

- First to use gonadotrophins for ovarian stimulation for IVF
- First to use transvaginal route for ovarian pick up
- First to use cryo preservation of human embryo and transfer them for the subsequent natural cycle.

An Oration in the memory of Professor Subhas Mukhopadhyay was introduced in the year 2012 and this prestigious oration is continuing on the first day of Annual Reunion of Calcutta National Medical College.

A proposal is under consideration in Health Department for naming the Gynae Block of Calcutta National Medical College and Hospital after Dr Subhas Mukhopadhya.

Calcutta National Medical College Alumni Association pays tribute and homage to this immortal soul and salutes one of our great alumnus.
